Introduction

One of the main objectives of the EPIX project is the promotion and supporting the ClusterXchange mechanism an initiative that allows organisations (clusters, companies, business support organizations and others) to improve their innovative and networking capacities through targeted visits to hosting organisations, exploring a foreign cluster and meeting potential partners to support short-term exchanges to better connect Europe's industrial ecosystems. The CXC programme enables them to innovate developing cross-sectorial and cross-regional strategies.





ClusterXchange facilitates transnational cooperation, peer learning, networking and innovation uptake between actors of different industrial clusters. It is implemented with support from cluster organisations that have teamed up in the European Cluster Partnerships. An exchange constitutes a stay abroad performed by a visiting organisation from an eligible country at a host organisation in another eligible country.

Exchanges in the EPIX project were used to:

- o Learn from actors in another cluster
- Explore growth opportunities in new markets
- o Adopt new technologies, digitalisation and green low-carbon solutions
- o Invest in strategic interregional collaboration

The types of activities visiting and host organisations carried out during EPIX exchanges were:

- Individual or grouped capacity-building
- o Sharing of knowledge, experience and information in specific areas
- \circ $\;$ Project development, innovation and research and development
- o Market research
- o Networking, identifying new partners and creating business opportunities

This success story kit has been developed to leverage the achievements of successful exchanges and bolster the outreach campaign. It encompasses comprehensive information on the **19 EPIX ClusterXchange missions** organized by partners throughout the project's duration. 
Objective

EPIX aimed at reinforcing business relationship between its cluster-partners, SMEs and cities in the booming world of Smart Cities. EPIX project encouraged clusters and entrepreneurs to participate in "smart city" interventions creating business-oriented networking and upskilling opportunities.

Mission

EPIX project increased skills and competences of clusters managers on 5 technological trajectories (smart energy, smart mobility and transportation, smart data, smart IoT devices, smart infrastructures) and on topics like sustainable smart cities, data sharing communities, public finance and investments. EPIX Consortium promoted cross cluster value chain interconnections to seize new growth opportunities emerging from smart cities technologies and data sharing communities and enhanced SMEs practical collaboration in joint projects for public procurements bids.

EPIX ClusterXchanges visitors' origin map


